Driverless Printing Using Mobile Devices with Novell iPrint Cheat Sheet

Novell iPrint Appliance is a virtual appliance that offers cross-platform and self-service printing for your enterprise. It allows users to print from your current printers by using their desktops, laptops, and mobile devices. The iPrint appliance runs as a virtual machine within any virtualization environment such as VMware, Windows Hypervisor, or Xen.

Follow the steps to deploy the Novell iPrint Appliance and get your first print by using your mobile device.

This is the user that you created in iManager. 4. Open a document that you want to print. 5. Tap the options button, then tap Share. 6. Tap Novell iPrint. 7. Tap Printers. 8. Tap the more icon in the upper-right corner of the screen, then choose a printer from the list of available printers. 9. Set your print preferences. 10. Tap Print.
